

Rabbis to Communities: Funding Guidelines



Communities generally cover the costs of a visiting Rabbi or Minister. However, if a community does require financial assistance, it may be eligible for partial funding from the Chief Rabbi's *Centre for Community Excellence* (CCE).

CCE can reimburse the host community up to a fixed amount for the various costs incurred during a Rabbi or Minister's visit. The remainder must be covered by the community. You can apply for funding [here](#).

Please note that the visiting Rabbi or Minister must submit his expenses and fee to the host community for payment. Following the visit, the community must then supply copies of relevant invoices and receipts to claim the pre-agreed grant from CCE.

Visiting Rabbi/Minister's fee

Item	Eligibility for CCE funding
Shabbat	CCE will give up to £350 towards the visiting Rabbi/Minister's fee.
Weekday visit	CCE will give up to £200 towards the visiting Rabbi/Minister's fee.
Festival	Case by case basis.

Accommodation & Travel Expenses

Item	Eligibility for CCE funding
Accommodation	CCE will give up to £100 per night for accommodation.
Petrol	CCE will reimburse up to 45p per mile.
